Mayo Clinic Florida has state of the art equipment for patient care, including next generation PET/CT, PET/MRI, and quantitative SPECT/CT. The clinical time for the fellow will include training in the following: general nuclear medicine studies, cardiac SPECT/PET, pediatric nuclear radiology, and PET imaging. Our division provides extensive experience with multiple clinical and research PET radiopharmaceuticals, including among others: F-18 PSMA DCFPyL, F-18 FDG, C-11 choline, F-18 fluciclovine, N-13 ammonia F-18 FES, Ga-68 DOTATATE. Additionally, you will join the division faculty in staffing a robust targeted radionuclide therapy practice which includes I-131, Y-90, Lu-177 DOTATATE, and Lu-177 PSMA.

The fellow will have an opportunity to rotate through the on-site cyclotron and small animal PET-CT facilities and to participate in research and quality improvement studies.

There will be option to spend time on other radiology services at Mayo Clinic Florida, including abdominal imaging, musculoskeletal imaging, and neuroradiology. There will also be elective time that the fellow can utilize to pursue personal areas of interest in imaging. During the fellowship, the fellow will participate in several recurring multidisciplinary conferences that afford close cooperative interaction with outstanding medical, surgical and pathology colleagues. Additionally, dedicated daily educational interactions at division and department level by way of lectures or group discussions can be expected.
