Program Information for Candidates

Enjoy the beautiful 143-acre Midwestern University campus, site of the OMM Clinic and Arizona College of Osteopathic Medicine, located in Glendale, Arizona. We are a not-for-profit University, with two full-time positions each year for our one-year residency (ONMM3) program. Our one-year curriculum provides training in osteopathic principles and practices, anatomy and all OMM techniques, as well as training in regenerative medicine and ultrasound.

The residency is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). Program Director Gary Gailius, D.O., trained at St. Barnabas Hospital in the Bronx, NY, and is board-certified by the AOBNMM.

The curriculum includes two months of OMM in-patient consultation service, in conjunction with a family medicine residency at a major teaching hospital with a diverse patient population. The residency didactics program includes time spent in the anatomy lab with Ph.D. anatomy professors, with a focus on functional anatomy.
