The Ohio State University Emergency Medicine Residency has an unexpected opening for a well-qualified applicant for a PGY-2 position with effective start date of July 1, 2022.

Applicants must: 1) have successfully completed at least one year in an ACGME accredited Emergency Medicine residency program, 2) be currently enrolled in an Emergency Medicine residency program in good standing and must have program director approval, OR 3) have successfully completed two or more years in an ACGME accredited program in another specialty, be in good standing and have the support of their current program director.

For consideration applicants should send:

- Cover Letter stating interest and reason for leaving program
- Current CV with reference list.
- USMLE Scores (Step 1, Step 2 CK & CS)
- Medical School Transcript and Diploma
- Medical Student Performance Evaluation (MSPE)/ Dean's letter
- A list of rotations completed in the PGY-1 year (or subsequent years if applicable)
- 2 letters of recommendation preferably from Emergency Medicine faculty
- Letter of recommendation from the Program Director is required
